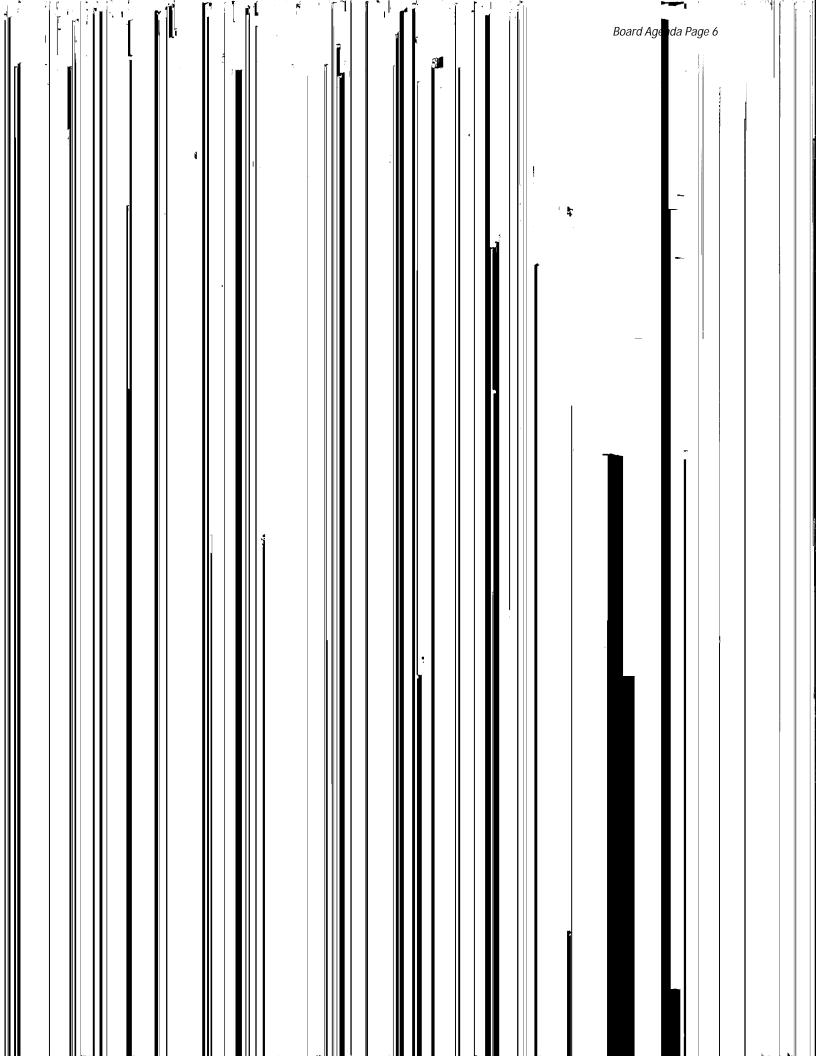
#### 1. Meetings with ExternalCommunity
